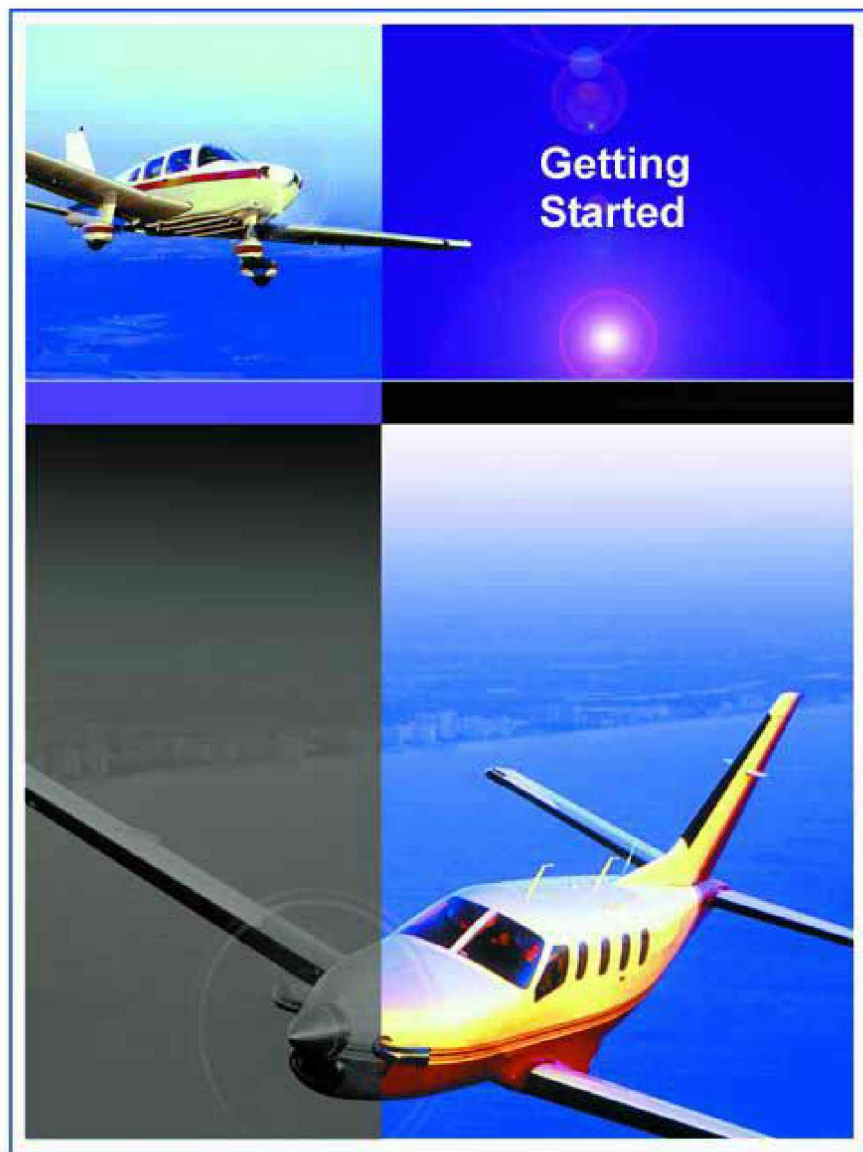


I:PASS - PRIVATE PILOT



Welcome!

Congratulations on buying the online, IPASS system and beginning a journey that can fulfill your dream of becoming a pilot. Becoming a pilot, like most things in life, begins with taking that all important first step. By purchasing this product you have already taken that step.

In actuality, the IPASS system is much more than a first step. With this program you have at your fingertips all you need to prepare for and pass the Private Pilot knowledge exam. This "Getting Started" introduction will help walk you through the steps to do that. Read these instructions carefully and you will be on your way.

Introduction To The Online Course

Watch each video carefully, in the order in which they are presented. You can "rewind" at any time to review points that you would like to see and hear again. Make sure that you complete the practice quiz at the end of each lesson. These quizzes are extremely important, both as a reinforcement of what has been taught and also as a tool to measure your grasp of the material. If you find that you get less than 80% on any quiz, we recommend that you view that lesson over again.

The same holds true for the end of course practice test. When you have completed all the material, take at least two of the final exam practice tests. If you do not score at least 80% review those portions where your knowledge is weak. It is very important that these practice test duplicate actual test conditions.

You can use the online manual to either follow along with the video or it can be used to reinforce the material presented in the videos.

After you satisfactorily complete the program, you will need to take the Private Pilot FAA knowledge exam. There are many sites around the country where you can go to take this computerized exam. You can find the location nearest you by going to this web site:

If you do not have Internet access, your flight instructor can direct you to the nearest testing location.

In order to take the FAA knowledge test you will need to have a "signoff" by a Certified Flight Instructor saying you have completed an appropriate home study course and are prepared to take the test. Print your completed exam results and give them to your flight instructor for review. He will be able to provide the "signoff" on the basis of successfully completing this home study course.

If you are unable to get a signoff from your local instructor, contact signoff@pilotwise.net to get instructions on how we can provide your signoff.

You will need to call the computer test site and make an appointment. You will need to take your signoff, a government issued picture ID, and the appropriate tools you will need to complete the exam, such as an E6B or electronic flight computer, plotter, etc.

Should you not pass the FAA knowledge test, you will be given a score report that contains subject matter codes indicating subject areas in which you have missed a question. A list of these codes can be found in Appendix E of the online written test preparation manual. Look up these codes and review thoroughly the appropriate areas in the manual and on the videos. In order to retake the FAA exam, the score report has a section that has to be signed by a CFI indicating you have received additional instruction and are ready to take the test.

This endorsement may be used by your local flight instructor to provide a signoff based on the use of a home study curriculum. See FAR 61.35 (a) (1)
